## LEGAL WARNING FROM ACM

## Data protection policy

1.- ACM advises users of the **ACM** portal that the company abide by current European legislation on matters of personal data protection, users' privacy and the secrecy and security of personal data by adopting the necessary technical and organisational measures to avoid the loss, misuse, alteration, unauthorised access or theft of the personal data provided, taking into account the state of the technology used, the nature of the data and the risks to which it is exposed.

2.- Specifically, ACM informs users of its portal that personal data can only be obtained for processing if they are appropriate, pertinent, and not excessive for the determined area and ends, explicit and legitimate, for which they were obtained. They will be cancelled when they are no longer necessary or pertinent for these ends, or when their owner requests they be cancelled. Any transfer of the personal data of users of this portal to third parties shall be duly communicated to those affected, specifying the identity of the recipients of the data and the uses to which they will be put.

3- **Use of IP addresses and cookies** browsing in **ACM** is the same as in any other website. The user leaves a trace of the IP address assigned in that session by the Access Provider. This IP address is recorded exclusively for internal use, such as for website access statistics. The IP address for the same user varies from one internet connection to another. Therefore, it is not possible to draw any conclusion as to the browsing habits of any particular user in **ACM** pages.

**ACM** may use cookies when a user browses its websites and pages. The cookies that can be used in the websites and web pages of **ACM** are only linked to the browser of a specific computer (an anonymous user) and alone do not only provide any personal data about the user. Cookies are exclusively for internal use, such as for website access statistics. The cookies used cannot read the cookie files created by other providers or websites. Users can configure their browsers so that they receive an on-screen alert when they receive cookies or to keep cookies from being stored on their hard drives. For more information, please consult the instructions and user manuals of your browser. To use **ACM** website, users are not required to allow the cookies to be stored.

The cookies used in the websites and web pages of **ACM** may be generated by ACM, in which case they are sent from the various servers operated by the company, or by servers of third parties that provide the company with services and generate their cookies on behalf of ACM; e.g. the cookies used to deliver advertising or certain content and allow the user to visualise the advertising or certain content in the time, number of times. As long as the option blocking the storage of cookies on the hard drive has not been selected, you may explore your hard disk by following the steps provided in the users' and help manuals of your operating system (normally, in Windows operating systems, this will be in the Windows/Cookies folder or the C or corresponding drive) for more details of each server from which cookies are sent.
